U16 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025

Technical Regulations & Programme

DATE & VENUE

The U16 National Championships will take place at the Germain Comarmond Stadium in Bambous from 09:00 AM on Saturdays, April 26 and May 3, 2025.

PARTICIPATION

The championships are open to Boys and Girls aged 13, 14, and 15, born in 2010, 2011, and 2012.

- · Each participant may compete in a maximum of three events.
- For track events, athletes are not allowed to compete in more than one event exceeding 300m.
- · A maximum of 2 relay teams per category is allowed.

COMPETITION PROGRAMME

All athletics events will be conducted in accordance with World Athletics (WA) regulations under the supervision of the Mauritius Athletics Association (MAA).
